● GAS ALERT: A device that can detect pollution and set off an alarm has been created by students at the University of Glasgow. The biosensor acts like coal mine canaries, which used to warn workers of gas leaks. A microbe detects gas, creating a chemical that makes a fuel cell generate electricity to trigger a warning sound. The device will be able to spot leaks at oil pipelines, factories and landfill sites.
